

**Leave M5 at junction 31**  
**Take A30 (Okehampton, Bodmin)**

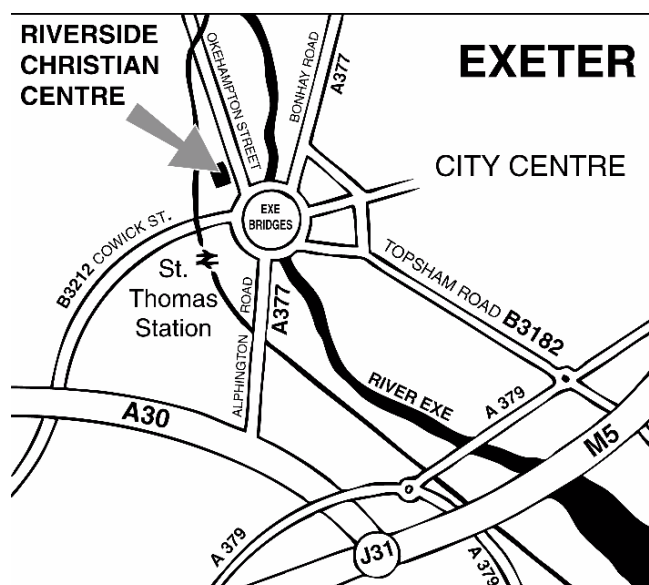
### **Alphington junction A377**

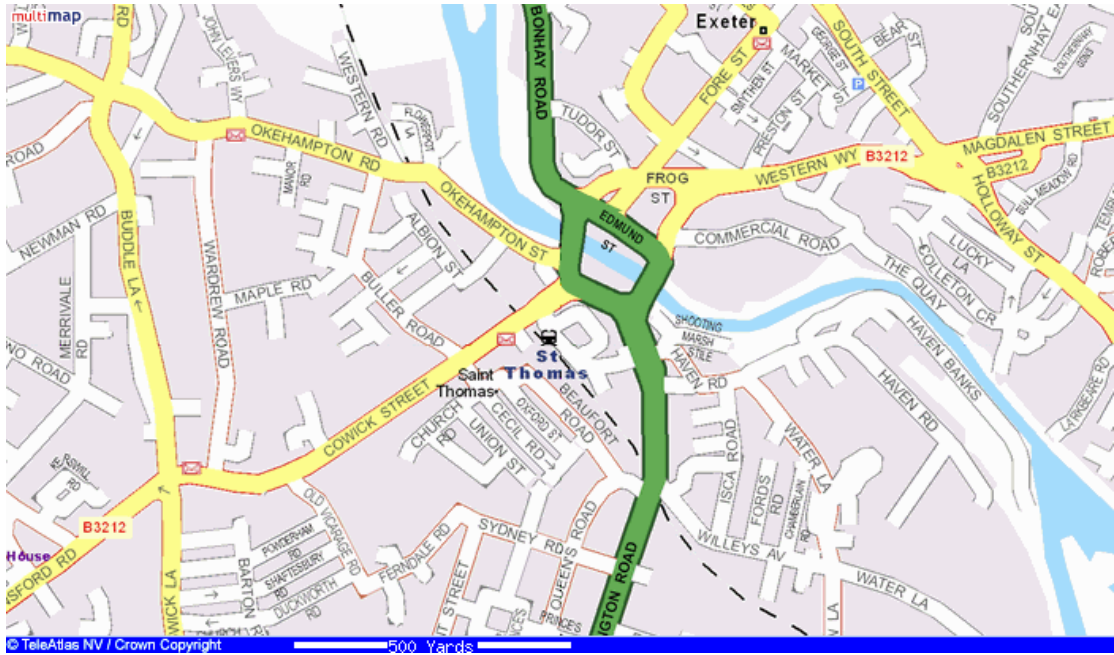
Branch left (signposted Exeter) then at roundabout take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit

### **Follow Alphington Road**

Keep going – you will pass on your right Sainsbury's , B & Q and staples

- on your left as you approach main traffic lights you will see Riverside Leisure Centre
- go straight on, keep to your left to next set of lights at Pizza Hut
- take the land ahead marked Exwick and at the next set of lights turn left into Okehampton Street
- Riverside Christian Centre is the large white building just around the corner
- There is parking further down the road to your right (Pay and Display) or a little further down on the bend to your right is a free car park (Flowerpot Lane). Both car parks do get filled quite early.
- There is limited parking right outside the building for the public, 2 hour slots. Some of the back roads have unlimited time parking and 2 hour slots.
- There are various car parks in town. There is a Park and Ride on the outskirts of town which would take you into town. There are details on the website [www.devon.gov.uk](http://www.devon.gov.uk) Then you can get a bus (an A, E or F) down to Cowick Street which is near to our building or walk down which would take 10 minutes.
- There are 3 train stations. Exeter Central is in the centre of town, a 20 min walk from us, Exeter St Davids is a 20 min walk to us and Exeter St Thomas (a small station) is just around the corner from us.
- There is a great website - [www.exeter.gov.uk](http://www.exeter.gov.uk) – which has great details on all the car parks in town with the cost and hours of opening. The Cathedral & Quay Car Park is only a ten minute walk from our centre.
